Alberta Raye White Stuart Cuthbertson taught in public schools for 42 years. She taught art, primarily at Dudley and Grimsley high schools.

She was the founding teacher for the Arts Honor Society at Grimsley High School and was the Chair of the Art Department.

In 2001, Mrs. Cuthbertson was appointed by then Governor Mike Easley to the North Carolina Arts Council.

She served as chapter president of Greensboro Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority from 1959-1962.

She was appointed as Chair of the Arts and Letters Committee in 1986 in which she served until her death in 2010.

In Memory of Mrs. Cuthbertson, the Greensboro Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. renamed this annual presentation, The Alberta W. Cuthbertson Visual and Performing Arts Program.
























































IN DEDICATION
